Featured Idaho investments: 2025 highlights

Through strategic grantmaking, we fund programs that build resilience in children and families, foster healthy and connected aging, and expand the behavioral health care workforce.

Community Health Outcomes (ECHO), Idaho Pediatric Psychiatry Access Line

Addressing Idaho's severe shortage of only 11 child-and-adolescent psychiatrists statewide, this grant supports the Pediatric Psychiatry Access Line initiative, which will connect pediatricians and families, especially in rural areas, to virtual behavioral health services.

Idaho Caregivers Alliance

With more than 10,000 Idaho children living in kinship family structures, this grant supports statewide efforts to address the behavioral health needs of older adults who serve as kinship caregivers, helping their overall health and well-being.

Idaho Botanical Garden

This grant supports expanding the horticulture therapy program to improve therapeutic outcomes and strengthen individual and community resilience by bringing people together in a healing space.
